

## DocWay Web Parts for SharePoint Frequently Asked Questions

**Question:** Does DocWay support SharePoint?

**Answer:** Yes. DocWay supports Microsoft Office SharePoint Server 2007, Microsoft Search Server 2008, and Windows SharePoint Services 3.0. DocWay ships with over 18 different Web Parts and has an extensibility model to allow customers to combine SharePoint, DocWay, and third-party Web Parts to create unlimited sites and pages to meet their enterprise content management needs.

DocWay Web Parts for SharePoint gives organizations complete integration between SharePoint and Documentum. User-friendly SharePoint portals are commonplace in today's corporate environment, but integrating Documentum systems has been complicated and time and resource intensive. When SharePoint portals need to be combined with enterprise-wide Documentum systems, corporate customers require a simple solution that scales for their large user base.

DocWay Web Parts provide functionality in three key areas: content interaction, search, and workflow interaction. All Web Parts work across multiple docbases and versions of Documentum and work either in isolation or in combination. The Web Parts are highly customizable and can be quickly and easily enhanced to match any specific needs of your organization.

**Question:** Do you support MOSS 2007 and WSS 3.0?

**Answer:** Yes. DocWay fully supports both MOSS 2007 and WSS 3.0.

**Question:** When editing documents through DocWay Web Parts for SharePoint, how is the document updated in SharePoint?

**Answer:** With DocWay Web Parts for SharePoint, the user is editing the document directly stored in Documentum using SharePoint as the access point. In this scenario, the user is able to take advantage of a variety of additional content management features that are native to Documentum and not provided by SharePoint, such as document lifecycles, renditions, and business process management services. The document is dynamically updated in the SharePoint views immediately after the user modifies it.

**Question:** Can the DocWay Web Parts run in a clustered SharePoint environment?

**Answer:** Yes. The DocWay Web Parts were built from the ground up to run in a clustered environment with minimal configuration.

**Question:** When browsing the Documentum repository inside of SharePoint, will users be able to see multiple docbases based on user permissions and roles?

**Answer:** Yes. User roles and permissions always govern the content that is viewable and actionable within the repository.

**Question:** When integrating the Office SharePoint Server 2007 environment with Documentum Content Server, what version of the Content Server must be used?

**Answer:** DocWay works with all service packs of Documentum 4i, 5.25, 5.3, 6.0 and 6.5.

**Question:** Does DocWay provide integration for SharePoint Portal Server 2003?
